Community Benefit Highlights**



Behavioral Health

Depression screening, using the PHQ2 followed by the PHQ9 or PHQ9-A for adolescents, is conducted for all patients aged 12 and older at least annually, resulting in 20 referrals for clinic patients to behavioral health providers and facilitating timely access to mental healthcare services.

Behavioral Health/Access to Care

Emergency Department (ED) providers screened patients for behavioral health needs, resulting in 10 patients being transferred to other health services, ensuring appropriate access to specialized mental healthcare and support.

Access to Vision Care

Recruitment efforts with Oakes Enhancement, Inc. (OEI) are complete. An optometrist was hired and began serving the community.
